Enable underserved youth to compete and excel academically and athletically at the highest personal and competitive levels through financial and educational support while striving to make competitive youth sports in Omaha/Council Bluffs an inclusive community.

In recent years, participation in competitive (sometimes referred to as 'select' or 'club') youth sports has become the best way for young athletes to receive quality training and often provides the best competitive atmosphere within the community. Most of these organizations are for-profit and charge substantial coaching, training, and uniform fees, which often prohibit otherwise talented young athletes from participating.

As a result, many economically disadvantaged young athletes are prevented from participating in athletics in the Omaha area. The economic exclusion has resulted in a significant decrease of minority youth participation in sports in Omaha/Council Bluffs. This is particularly evident in all youth sports in the area

The S.A.V.E. program targets young athletes in the Omaha area who have a desire to play competitive sports by providing them with financial assistance. This enables the athlete to participate in the best training environment for his/her chosen sport while also providing educational support to help the young athlete succeed in school. S.A.V.E. uses sports as an avenue to promote the importance of education. S.A.V.E. provides opportunities to the young athlete by offering encouragement, support, and enabling the athlete to develop qualities to succeed in all he or she does in life.
